In the upcoming weeks we will be dedicating time to work through the details of the two upcoming leases with Revv Aviation and Apex Aero Center. This will include time with our Attorney Rob Livingston. We have recently learned that our Auditor has recently sold their practice to another firm in the metro. We are working with the City Finance Department and are hopeful that this will not delay our report to the city.
